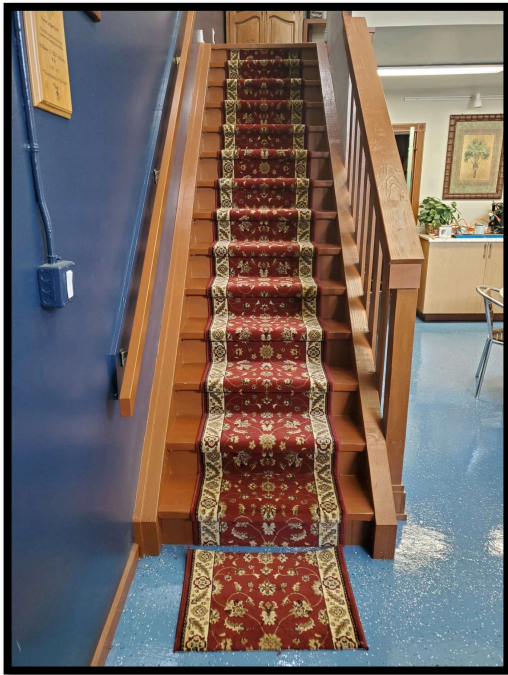


Here is the Domino family enjoying a Kona Staycation Day.

Stairs to the upstairs conference room



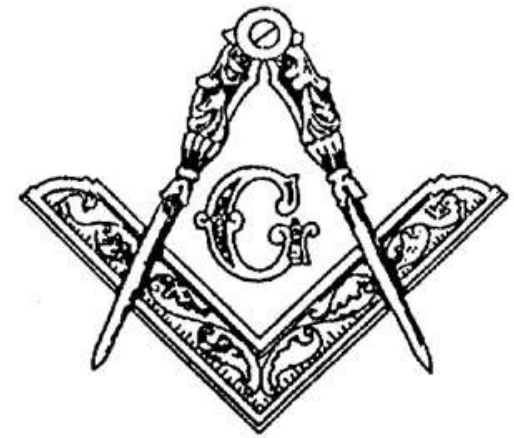
This is the new entrance to the Lodge Room.
